

Conspiracy of Kindness

IT'S A RADICAL IDEA.

What if we all spent a little less on ourselves and on the trappings of Christmas this year and pooled what we saved and gave it away? It could truly change a life!

At Grace, we have participated in the Conspiracy of Kindness for the past five years. The Conspiracy of Kindness is based on four principles:

Worship Fully – Christmas begins and ends with Jesus.

Spend Less – Free up resources to support things that truly matter.

Give More – Give more intentionally and relationally.

Love All – Radically love others like Jesus did.



Here's what we have been able to accomplish TOGETHER over the past several years that we would not have been able to do by ourselves:

- Built a church in the mountains of Mexico.
- Paid the salary of a pastor in the Dominican Republic for two years and gave their church funds to invest in their local community.
- Provided a vehicle for a family that needed reliable transportation.
- Sponsored the education of 4 children in Liberia, where this pathway to a new life is not free but requires families to pay for it.
- Supported families in their adoption process, bringing hope to these children and new lives.
- Helped furnish a home for a family after a fire destroyed everything they had.
- Provided food and shelter for 100 refugees from Venezuela who were settling in Ecuador.
- Provided food and health supplies for hundreds of Mexicans living in the remote mountains of Mexico.
- Paid for seminary level education for 2 Mexican Nationals working in church planting.

Last year we gave away over \$32,000 as part of our conspiracy. Since last November, the gifts you gave were used to:

- Support a church expansion in Brazil
- Encourage seven families who have shared the love of Christ through adoption and fostering
- Meet needs for eight other families experiencing temporary financial hardships
- Give an "Over and Above" gift to Real Options

Over the last 5 years, Grace has given away over \$115,000 to 56+ individuals or organizations around the world! This is on top of our normal mission's commitment of 10% of our income.

This year we are taking a slightly different approach with our Conspiracy of Kindness. The elders selected two areas to focus our Kindness giving this season and hope to learn of other ministry opportunities through nominations from the body. The two areas selected are (1) Missions, and (2) Local needs. For Missions, our goal is to partner with Breaking Cycles Ministry and raise ~\$16,000 which will be used to fund the building of 5 homes and 10 bunk beds in Guatemala this summer.

As your household makes plans for this Christmas season, we want to encourage you to participate with us in our Conspiracy of Kindness. This can be a great way to teach your children about the love of God for all people.

We are excited to see how God will provide and use these “over-and-above normal giving” gifts so that together we can bless families and gospel-centered ministries.

HOW CAN YOU PARTICIPATE?

Nominate someone.

Give.

Pray about how you will spend less to give more, and then contribute to our Conspiracy of Kindness Fund. You can give a check or cash in an envelope and place it in the offering or mail it to the church. *Please designate it as Conspiracy of Kindness.*

Conspiracy of Kindness Guidelines and Considerations



The decision as to what projects to support for our Conspiracy of Kindness will include the consideration of these conditions and outcomes:

- Will it result in a life change that could break a cyclical pattern or help in overcoming a temporary situation?
- Will it lead to a reproducible blessing – the planting of a “seed” which could grow into more individuals or families blessed by the initial gift?
- Is this a need which is not likely to be met by other sources – such as family, other givers, government aid or other funding sources?
- Does it lead to the resolution of an issue or problem rather than becoming a “band-aid” for an ongoing need?
- Would it be recognized as a blessing from Jesus for which glory can be given to Him and the potential for future spiritual understanding and growth developed?

POSSIBLE KINDS OF CONSPIRACY OF KINDNESS PROJECTS:

- Purchase an automobile/wheelchair/special equipment, etc.
- Pay for a needed surgery which would otherwise be unattainable.
- Drill a water well for a community
- Build a church.
- Pay the cost of housing for a refugee family.
- Provide an educational scholarship or job training.
- Fund a Bible translation for a people group without the Bible.
- Build or remodel a house for someone who has no home.
- Purchase farm animals to establish an ongoing farm community.
- Provide the finances to begin a micro-business for someone in a developing country
- Purchase school supplies for children who could not otherwise attend school.
- Build or rehab someone’s home for handicap accessibility.

PLEASE NOTE THAT THIS IS NOT INTENDED TO JUST BE CHRISTIANS HELPING CHRISTIANS.

We want to help those who don’t know Jesus so that they might know the love of Jesus expressed through us.
